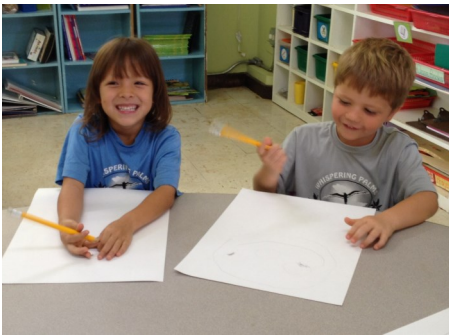
Parent Conferences Tomorrow
